

## AUDIO-VISUAL DAYSCHOOL

On Saturday 30th October we are running a full day's workshop style dayschool at Wilmslow Guild. It is aimed at people who are probably, though not necessarily, photographers, and who are seeking a more creative outlet for their pictures. Either people who wish to find out what A-V involves, or who definitely wish to start, or people who have already done some A-V but want to make sure that they are going in the right direction.

The day will be led by Suzanne Walker ARPS and Howard Gregory. Artistic and technical considerations will be covered, and all stages in A-V production will be described and performed on the big screen. After each demonstration, students will be able to try it on their own laptops, in a relaxed atmosphere, and with help available. There will be plenty of time for questions and discussion. Don't worry if you haven't a laptop.

The presentations will be supplemented by handouts.

During the day we hope to cover the following topics:

- Overview of the sequence production process
- Ideas, structure - a sequence is more than a series of pictures
- Setting up a file structure on your computer
- Importing and preparing images
- Importing and preparing music
- Setting images to music - timeline etc
- Fades and transitions - keep it simple and appropriate
- Matching style, mood etc
- Adding a voice-over
- A look at more advanced techniques.
